

COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION APPLICATION

N.J.S.A 2C:7-1 et seq., commonly know as “Megan’s Law,” entitles organizations, with supervisory control over children and women, to information concerning the release of known sexual offenders who meet certain criteria.

Pursuant to the law, organizations must register with their local police departments, or the State Police who service their area. A determination will then be made by the Prosecutor’s Office as to which groups qualify for notification under the law.

Please complete the form below and return it to the appropriate police agency. If the Prosecutor’s Office determines your organization or agency falls within the statute, you will be notified of the release and whereabouts of certain sex offenders. Any changes to this information should be forwarded to the Morris County Prosecutor’s Office immediately. ATTENDANCE AT AN ANNUAL NOTIFICATION TRAINING PROGRAM WILL BE REQUIRED TO BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE THIS INFORMATION.
